NEIGHBORHOOD




East Rosedale Street activated to create open spaces, central neighborhood hub for essential services and amenities.











HOUSE HOUSE

Hughes House I – 4830 & 4908 E. Rosedale St.

- 162-unit, mixed-income, mixeduse community
- Approx. 8,800 sq. ft. commercial space
- Construction commenced in April 2023.
- Construction progress currently at 56% complete
- Construction and lease-up schedule:
 - Substantial completion May 2025
 - Pre-Leasing Late Winter 2024/Early Spring 2025



- The input meetings will include several community meetings to get input from the community prior to moving forward into the construction documents







- Provided a four-week summer academic enrichment camps
- Parenting virtual and in-person back-to-school readiness workshops
- Hosted a back-to-school family engagement event
- Partnered with Fort Worth ISD to host early learning and enrollment fair



- To bolster the Attendance Works framework, two former Cavile residents will be selected to receive stipends, contributing to the ongoing commitment to improving school attendance in the community.
- Preparations for residents transitioning to Hughes House are underway, with lease timeframes continuously monitored to ensure a smooth move.
- On-going back-to-school support initiatives are ongoing, ensuring that families are adequately supported throughout the academic year.
- Career Development and Assessment Workshop to bolster support for unemployed individuals in developing their career paths and exploring job opportunities.
- We will commence our fall series of in-person and virtual parenting classes, offering valuable resources and guidance to parents on social and emotional well-being.
- Hosting high school senior meet and greet will be hosted for all ten rising graduating seniors, providing an opportunity for connection and celebration as they approach a significant milestone in their academic journey.
